



# High-Impact Practices: What are they?



#### Engagement

An investment of time + effort in purposeful tasks that deepen learning and engagement.



#### Interaction

They promote meaningful connections with faculty, peers, and community members both inside and outside the classroom.



#### Reflection

They include opportunities for reflection and feedback that help students integrate and apply what they learn.



#### Relevance

These practices link academic learning to real-world contexts, such as internships, research, and service learning.



#### Accessible

When implemented intentionally, HIPs ensure equitable participation and outcomes for all students.

# Institutional Support & Capacity Building

- Support **implementation** of needs assessment
- Match institutions with technical assistance
- Facilitate feedback loops to surface insights, barriers, and opportunities across participating institutions

# Implementation Monitoring & Learning

- Observe and advise on fidelity to project goals; flag risks and successes
- Foster **peer learning** and communities of practice
- Collect and synthesize institutional learnings & promising practices

# Collaboration & Dissemination

- Engage in crossintermediary collaboration to share resources and to align strategies
- Share project findings through resources to influence the broader fields
- Participate in project
   convening & support
   institutional preparation





Demonstrated commitment to intentionally embedding career preparation into curricular or cocurricular experiences.



Demonstrated experience in implementing and assessing multiple HIPs (beyond isolated programs or majors).




Priority consideration to: American Association of State Colleges and Universities member institutions, Seal of Excelencia certified institutions, and HBCUs (private or public).








